3. Course Content Description

servants.

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- Four Stages of Education System Development: Ancient, Opium War, People's Republic of China, and present.







- Fundamental Knowledge of Modern Chinese Educational Segments: Pre-school Education, Primary and Secondary Education, Higher Education and Vocational Education.
 - Cultural, Leadership & Philosophic Aspects for doing Global Business.
 - Practice experiences of the Chinese HR environment in private and public organizations.
